Enjoy special cruises on Lakes Maggiore, Como and Orta. Visit the Borromean Islands, feast your eyes on Leonardo's "The Last Supper," and learn culinary secrets during a cooking lesson. From romantic Isola San Giulio to charming Bellagio and chic Milan to elaborate villas, this is a tour of northern Italy's stunning beauty.

Active: Walk 2+ miles on flat/uneven terrain, including up and down inclines; navigate 100+ stairs; stand 3+ hours

Day 1 | Depart gateway city

AHI FlexAir passengers depart for Milan, Italy. Please check your luggage from your gateway city to your arrival city. Your claim checks should have the following airport code: MXP.

Day 2 | Stresa, Italy

Arrive at Milan Malpensa Airport. Proceed through immigration to the baggage claim area and retrieve your luggage. After completing customs, AHI FlexAir passengers traveling on flights that qualify for the group arrival transfer and Land Program passengers who have purchased seats on the group transfer should exit the baggage claim area and proceed to the Arrivals Hall, where an AHI Travel representative will meet you.

Transfer and check in to the Hotel La Palma. Please note, if you arrive before check-in time, your room may not be immediately available.

This evening, join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception and Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 | Lake Orta

Enjoy a full American-style breakfast buffet each morning.

Enrichment: The Development of the Lake District. Learn about Italy's beautiful Lake District, a haven of Alpine peaks, gardens and lakes.

Lake Orta. Enjoy a scenic drive to the lovely resort town of Orta San Giulio, located on a peninsula that juts into Lake Orta. During a walking tour of this small Italian town, see the central piazza, and absorb the charms of idyllic lakeside life. Then board a boat to visit Isola San Giulio, the enchanted island in the lake. Appreciate the beauty of the island's ancient Romanesque basilica that flaunts medieval frescoes, an 11th-century great bell tower and polychrome wooden sculptures. An immense fossilized vertebra hangs in the sacristy. Legends claim that the vertebra is from one of the island's dreadful dragons that bullied the area before being slayed by San Giulio. (Moderate)

Free Time: Enjoy free time in Orta San Giulio for lunch and make your own discoveries. Drink in the lake's stillness from a lakeside bench or admire views from the Chiesa dell' Assunta, a coral-hued parish church perched on a small hill.

Gather for a dinner of local flavors at a restaurant in town. Many menus in this region are crafted using family heirloom recipes and locally sourced meats, fish and seasonal vegetables as well as cheeses, breads and wines.

Day 4 | Stresa | Borromean Islands

Enrichment: The Gardens of Lake Maggiore. Immerse yourself in history as a local expert shares a narration of Lake Maggiore. Learn about the powerful Borromeo family and how they transformed the tranquil islands — that now are named after them — into splendid retreats featuring palaces and landscaped gardens.

Free Time: Head out to enjoy Stresa and lunch on your own during time at leisure this morning.

Borromean Islands. Located in the turquoise waters of Lake Maggiore, the Borromean Islands are named after the family who acquired them in the 14th century and still own two of them, Isola Madre and Isola Bella, today. This island group consists of three lovely islands, each one different from its neighbors. Begin your outing with a cruise on Lake Maggiore aboard a private motorboat to Isola Madre, the largest of the Borromean Islands. Enjoy a guided visit of the island's extensive botanical gardens. The impressive English-style gardens are lush and filled with exotic flowers, rare plants, and ancient trees. You may also spot some of the delightful peacocks, parrots, and pheasants that make their home on the island. Then, embrace the rustic charm of the peaceful fishing village of Isola dei Pescatori. Stroll its narrow streets lined by the quaint houses of the fishermen and families who call this island home. Finally, enjoy a special, private visit to Isola Bella, the "Beautiful Island," extolled by writers over the centuries. Explore its 17th-century baroque palace and summerhouse that is home to a mosaic grotto and an astounding collection of art and antiques. Cap off the excursion with a lovely reception in the island's hanging gardens. (Moderate)

Day 5 | Bellagio | Como

Bellagio. Enjoy a boat ride to Bellagio on Lake Como. Often thought of as the most beautiful town in Italy, Bellagio flaunts a promenade lined with lime trees and oleanders, a quaint city center of cobblestone streets and picturesque alleyways, and charming buildings painted in shades of cream, peach and butterscotch. Poets and writers from every part of the world have visited and found inspiration in Bellagio including Pliny the younger, Longfellow, Mark Twain, Shelley, Stendhal, Flaubert, Faure, Liszt and Toscanini. Explore this enchanting little village, and stroll by 18th- and 19th-century villas built by the region's noble families. (Moderate)

Free Time: Discover Bellagio on your own during some free time. Take a romantic stroll along the waterfront, pause for a treat at a requisite gelato stand, or duck inside a wonderful artisan bakery.

Join your fellow travelers for lunch at one of Bellagio's lakeside restaurants.

Cruising Lake Como. After lunch, travel by private boat from Bellagio to Como, one of the most romantic ways to experience this region. Glide on deep-blue water, gloriously bathed with rays of golden sunlight, and delight in views of the opulent villas and colorful villages nestled along Lake Como's shores. Vistas of stunning gardens, hidden

waterfalls and cypress groves will captivate your senses, while the majestic Alps stand sentry in the background. Your spectacular, poetic boat ride is sure to be among your trip's most treasured memories. (Moderate)

Arrive in Como, a historic town situated on the shores of the lake of the same name, and join your group for a short walking tour, beginning at Piazza Cavour.

Dinner is at leisure this evening. Share in the day's experiences with friends at a favorite restaurant.

Day 6 | Stresa

Enrichment: Golden Age of the Renaissance. Delve into the true genius of Michelangelo and Leonardo da Vinci and trace their profound influences on sculpture and painting.

Flavors of Italy. Learn the secrets of northern Italian cuisine during an interactive cooking lesson from a local family at their restaurant. Then sit down with your fellow travelers to delight in conversation and a delicious lunch overlooking Lake Maggiore. (Moderate)

Free Time: The afternoon is free for you to craft your own adventures in Stresa. Soak up a sun by the harbor or settle in at a local café for a light snack or cocktail.

Enrichment: Contemporary Italy. Learn about current events and life in Italy today during an engaging discussion with a local speaker.

Day 8 | Milan

A Cultural Visit to Milan. Travel to Milan, Italy's economic powerhouse, whose wealth of cultural heritage is lavished on superb architecture, splendid art, and prestigious museums. Take a memorable trip to the beautiful Renaissance Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie to see Leonardo's magnificent "The Last Supper." This powerful painting is hailed as one of the greatest in the world, and it took da Vinci two years to complete. He used models he found on the streets of Milan for his depictions of Christ and his followers. Continue to the museum at the legendary La Scala, Italy's opulent, premier opera house. Enter the flamboyant 14th-century Duomo, a Gothic masterpiece defended by 2,244 marble saints and nearly 100 scowling gargoyles. The Duomo's impressive interior houses Europe's largest sundial, a brass strip decorated with signs of the zodiac embedded in its floor, and the treasury, which houses some of the Duomo's prized possession. (Moderate)

Free Time: Spend time at leisure having lunch and getting to know cosmopolitan Milan. You may wish to explore Milan's legendary fashion scene while walking along the streets of Quadrilatero d'Oro, one of the world's most iconic fashion districts. **Enrichment: Contemporary Italy.** Enjoy an engaging discussion of Italy's current economy, politics, society and role in the European Union.

This evening, attend a special Farewell Reception and Farewell Dinner. Raise a toast to your Italian sojourn!

Robert Gurval is Associate Professor Emeritus in the UCLA Department of Classics. His area of research and teaching concerns ancient Rome and the legacy of its empire in popular culture and cinema. Gurval's publications focus on politics, literature and architecture in the age of Rome's first emperor, Caesar Augustus. Cleopatra and her reception in western culture is a special interest. Gurval has taught at UCLA since 1990 where he has served as Chair of the Department of Classics and Chair of the faculty committees on the Honors College, General Education Governance, and Undergraduate Honors, Awards and Prizes. Among his academic honors, he was a Rome Prize Fellow at the American Academy in Rome. In 2025, he received the Carole E. Goldberg Emeriti Service Award in recognition of his continued contributions to the field of Classics and the university, including his enthusiasm for sharing his knowledge of the ancient world as a faculty lecturer in UCLA Alumni Travel tours.

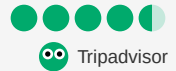
